

UPDATES ON THE REVIEW OF THE EU INDUSTRIAL EMISSIONS DIRECTIVE AND THE EUROPEAN POLLUTANT RELEASE AND TRANSFER REGISTER



The European Commission will soon propose a revision of EU measures addressing pollution from large industrial installations, as announced in the [European Green Deal](#). The aims of the revision are to progress towards the EU's zero pollution ambition for a toxic-free environment and to support climate, energy and circular economy policies. Both proposals for the review of the EU Industrial Emissions Directive (IED), and the review of the European Pollutant Release and Transfer Register (E-PRTR), are expected at the end of 2021.

The EEB has been actively involved in all critical steps of the processes so far, communicating the demands of environmental NGOs to policymakers, most notably by providing technical input to the Targeted Stakeholder Surveys (TSS).

A kick-off online stakeholder information workshop followed on 15 December 2020. The morning meeting was dedicated to the IED review, and the afternoon session to the closely related E-PRTR review. Find further information about the meeting [here](#).
